



**Required Procedure for Passengers Arriving to Lebanon from the UK
starting the 1st of June 2021**

All passengers arriving to Lebanon must:

1. Perform the PCR test no longer than 96 hours before travel and to show the test result at check-in counters. (Children under 12 years old are exempted from this requirement)

Passengers without a negative PCR test result are not allowed to board the plane departing to Lebanon.

2. Book a hotel at their own expenses for 5 days/4 nights in one of the following hotels:

Passengers without a hotel booking in one of the hotels mentioned above will not be allowed to board the plane departing to Lebanon.

3. Perform a PCR test upon their arrival to Beirut Airport.
4. Upon arrival to Beirut Airport, Buses from the above mentioned hotels will transport the passengers from the airport to the **hotels where they shall remain quarantined for 5 days/4 nights**, during which they will perform another PCR test in one of the labs authorized by MoPH at their own expenses.



Exemptions:

1. Diplomats (foreign and national) with their families are exempted from hotel quarantine, instead they quarantine at their place of residence for the same abovementioned duration.
2. Vaccinated passengers who have **received their second dose of the Covid-19 vaccine minimum 2 weeks before their departure date**, and passengers who **were infected and cured from Covid-19 no more than 90 days before their departure date provided they present an official document*** confirming that, are exempted from performing a PCR test in the UK and from hotel quarantine, and shall only perform a PCR test upon arrival to Beirut Airport.

*A recent negative test with a positive test lasting more than 15 days, or a positive IgG test showing the percentage of these antibodies in the blood above the required rate according to each measurement technique, provided that the MOPH representatives at the airport review the medical case and approves it.
