



**Required Procedure for Passengers Arriving to Lebanon from the UK starting
January 18, 2022**

**All passengers including vaccinated passengers excluding children under 12 years of age
arriving to Lebanon must:**

- 1- Perform a PCR test in a certified lab latest 48 hours before departure.
Passengers who have received the second dose of any Covid-19 vaccine or a complete dose of Covid-19 vaccine can perform a **COVID-19 Rapid Antigen Test including QR code (must be performed in a certified Lab)** latest 24 hours before departure.
- 2- Register on the **MOPH PASS** platform of the Ministry of Public Health through the following link: <https://PASS.MOPH.GOV.LB> and to make sure that all the sent information is correct, before obtaining a **MOPH PASS**. The test's result must be uploaded on the platform mentioned above where a QR code will be created and sent to the passenger. The QR code will be scanned upon arrival at Beirut Airport in order to ensure that the passenger's information is correct.
- 3- Perform a PCR test at Beirut Airport.
- 4- The payment for the PCR test performed at Beirut airport (**\$30**) must be paid in advance through two options:
 - a. Online payment via credit card through the platform.
 - b. Through the Airline coming on board.
- 5- Passengers must remain quarantined at home until they are informed of the test result (within 24 hours via text message and email).
- 6- If the PCR test result is positive, the passenger must immediately call the Covid-19 Hotline **1787** at the Ministry of Public Health, in case he was not contacted by the ministry team.
