Important updates on COVID-19 preventive measures

All passengers arriving to Lebanon must:

-Perform the PCR test in a Lab certified by the local authorities latest 96 hours between the test result and the date of arrival to Lebanon and to show the test result at check-in counters. (Children under 12 years old are exempted from this requirement).

Passengers without negative PCR test result are not allowed to board the plane departing to Lebanon.

-Complete the medical form issued by the Lebanese Ministry of Public Health before their arrival to Lebanon (available electronically on the following link <http://arcg.is/0GaDnG>).

-Passengers are then allowed to choose between:

1. Conducting a second PCR test latest 72 hours after their arrival to Beirut at their own expense.

or

2. Self Isolating for a period of 10 days from the date of their arrival to Lebanon.

Exemptions:

Passengers who travelled outside of Lebanon and are returning within one week, are exempted from conducting PCR tests in the countries of departure.
